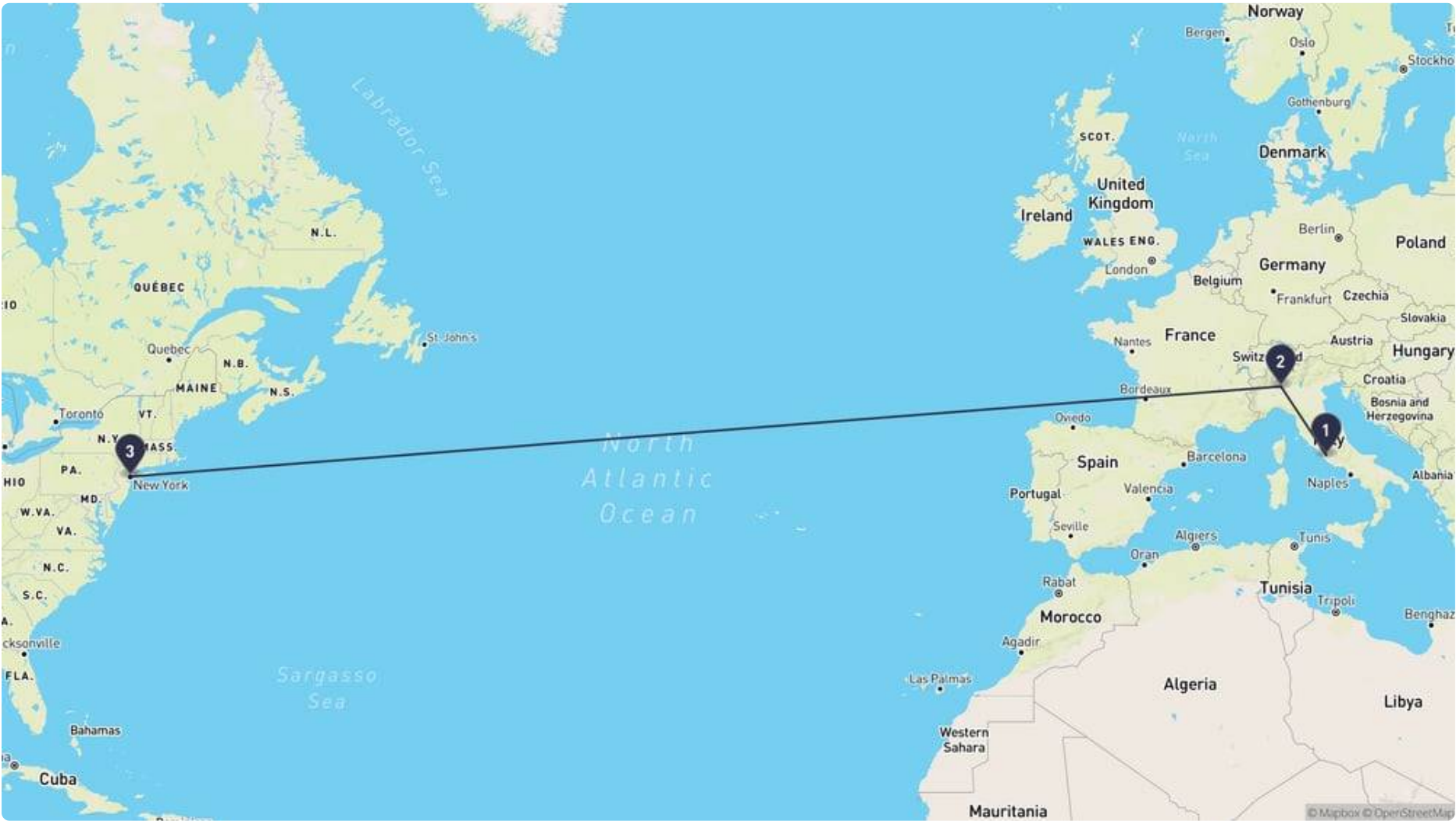

Capture memories with a photo stop at the Pigna statue in the Pinecone Courtyard, crafted by the renowned

Donato Bramante. Join our English speaking expert guide for an unforgettable experience in the heart of the Vatican City! Duration: 1 hour and 15 minutes. Ticket included.

The Pineyard Courtyard at the Vatican Museums is a serene haven, blending classic architecture with lush greenery. Donato Bramante's Pigna statue stands as a bronze centerpiece, creating a peaceful retreat. Amidst this cultural richness, the courtyard invites reflection and appreciation for its timeless elegance.
